Objective

To train independent researchers with an inter and multidisciplinary approach, capable of analyzing, interpreting and explaining border social processes and phenomena from the spatial and symbolic dimensions, observed from the logic of power either diachronically or synchronically, with the support of theoretical and methodological contributions and analytical categories common to geography, economics, sociology, communication, anthropology and history, who contribute with original research to the advancement of scientific knowledge and the improvement of social and community welfare.

Admission requirements

- Have a master's degree, preferably in an area related to those indicated in the objective Doctorate in Society, Space and Power (DESEP).
- To have obtained in the master's degree a grade point average equal to or higher than 80.
- Proof of proficiency in a foreign language (TOEFL, IELTS, LEL or similar).
- Pass the propaedeutic course.
